The prize consists of a two-day trip in New Brunswick for two people, which includes lodging, meals, and gasoline for snowmobiles over the those two days, as well as the right to access the trails in New Brunswick.

In order to participate in the Contest, you only need to fill the registration form below.

Each participant can only register once a day. However, in order to increase his/her chances, a participant can register every day starting at noon, on October 20th, 2017, up the contest deadline on March 31st, 2018.

This contest is reserved only for Quebec residents of 18 years old and above at the time they register.

The draw will take place in Sainte-Luce, on April 2nd, 2018, at 2pm (local time).

Contest rules

1. Contest Period

This contest is sponsored by and operated by Motoneiges.ca (**hereafter the "Sponsor"**). The contest starts at 12:00 (noon) Eastern Time (ET) on October 20th, 2017, and closes at 11:59:59 PM (ET) on March 31st, 2018 ("**Contest Period**").

2. Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the Contest, a person must :

- . be a Quebec resident;
- . have reached the age of majority at the time of registration;

THE CONTEST IS NOT VALID WHERE LAWS OR REGULATIONS FORBID IT.

The employees, officers, and administrators of the Sponsor and respectively its affiliated companies, subsidiaries, advertising agencies, promotion agencies, couponing and marketing agencies, its partners in the contest, as well all the members of their immediate families (i.e. parents, children, brothers, sisters or spouses) and the people living under the same roof as those people (be they related or not) are not eligible to the contest.

3. Registration

Electronic participation

In order to participate electronically to the contest, an eligible person must fill the electronic registration form and to supply the required information as part of the contest (i.e. first name, last name, mailing address, postal code, email address, and phone number). The participant can only register once per calendar day. However, in order to increase their chances, he/she can register again each day throughout the contest period.

An official piece of identity with name and mailing address can be required in order to validate the registration after the draw.

4. Prize offered

In all, one (1) Prize will be attributed during the contest period (hereafter "the Prize"). The Prize consists of a two-day trip in New Brunswick for two people, which includes lodging, meals, gasoline for snowmobiles over the those two days, as well as the right to access the trails in New Brunswick. In addition, the Winner will be guided by a representative of the New Brunswick Federation of Snowmobile Clubs, as well as a representative from Motoneiges.ca. magazine. The trip will take place during the 2018-2019 snowmobile season at one or the other of the dates proposed by the organizers.

The prize draw will take place at 2 PM, on April 2nd, 2018, in the offices of Motoneiges.ca, located at 13 des Sapins, Sainte-Luce (Quebec), G0K 1P0.

During the draw, one (1) winner will be selected at random amongst all the valid registrations received over the eligibility period, in accordance with the present regulations.

The Prize must be accepted as given and is not transferrable, nor redeemable. No prize substitution is allowed.

The Grand Prize in the form of an invitation for the trip will be sent by mail to the winner at the address indicated on the registration form. 14. SEVERABILITY
